**SUBJECT :** 2015 Young Leader's Program (YLP) of the Government of Japan

The Civil Service Commission as the recommending authority of the Young Leader's Program (YLP) School of Government course is pleased to invite you to send a nominee for the said program.

The YLP aims to: a) cultivate future national leaders in Asia and around the world; b) create network among the participants; and c) improve the quality of policy planning activities of participating countries. The course duration is one (1) year from October 2015 to September 2016, resulting in the conferment of a Master's Degree in Public Administration/Public Policy by the National Graduate Institute for Policy Studies (GRIPS), Tokyo, Japan.

Applicants shall meet the following requirements:

- Under 40 years old as of October 1, 2015
- Must hold a Bachelor's degree from a recognized university or college and have achieved excellent academic performance;
- At least three (3) years work experience in public administration; and
- Must be in good health.

The scholarship benefits include allowance in the amount of 242,000 yen per month for 12 months, air fare and transportation expenses, tuition fees and accommodation.

Nominees must pass the screening of the agency's Personnel Development Committee (PDC) pursuant to CSC Memorandum Circular No. 10, s. 1989 before the same shall be endorsed to the CSC for further screening and evaluation by the CSC YLP Screening Committee.
