SUBJECT: Observance of the 19th National Awareness Week for the Prevention of Child Sexual Abuse and Commercial Sexual **Exploitation** 

Proclamation No. 731, s. 1996, declares the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of February of every year as "National Awareness Week for the Prevention of Child Sexual Abuse and Commercial Sexual Exploitation" also known as "Child Sexual Abuse Awareness Week (CSAAW)".
