The **ADHD Society of the Philippines** is a parent-based organization founded in 2000 and organized for the purpose of providing support to individuals with AD/HD, their families and professionals who work with them through family empowerment, advocacy and networking with stakeholders.

The Society has successfully raised the level of awareness on ADHD through seminars, training workshops and media publicity so that Filipinos are now more aware that early identification and treatment increase the likelihood of positive long-term outcomes. It has undertaken the following projects and activities for this purpose:

### VISION

The AD/HD Society of the Philippines is a dynamic, compassionate, responsive and non-biased parent-based organization where support group for persons with AD/HD are accessible to ensure the full attainment of their Godgiven potentials.

### MISSION

To provide support to individuals with AD/HD, their families and caregivers through family empowerment, advocacy and networking with other stakeholders.

### GOALS

To develop and implement programs, projects and activities which promote the well-being of persons with AD/HD.



The government has recognized the Society's efforts through the years. On September 18, 2003, then President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo declared Presidential Proclamation No. 4772 declaring the third week of October of every year as National ADHD Awareness Week. In September 29, 2015, former President Benigno

Simeon Aquino presented the PWD Group Award (from the Philippine Foundation For the Rehabilitation of the Disabled, Inc.) to the ADHD Society of the Philippines for its "UNRELENTING EFFORTS TO EDUCATE THE NATION ON UNDERSTANDING AND MANAGING THE CONDITION OF INDIVIDUALS WITH ADHD..."

# **Programs**

**SEMINARS/WORKSHOPS** — organized regularly to provide an avenue for the discussion of timely and relevant topics on the effective management of ADHD at home and in school:

**PARENT TRAINING CLASSES** — a training course for parents on behavior management and other skills needed in the proper handling of a child with ADHD at home:

**SUPPORT GROUPS** — organized and conducted by the Society (in partnership with local government units) for parents and caregivers to discuss their various concerns on children with ADHD;

**ADHD SCHOOL CARAVAN** — a public awareness campaign on ADHD for private and public schools nationwide. It also includes an Awareness Seminar for the general public and a Teacher Training Seminar on classroom management for educators.

**SUMMER CAMP**— a whole daycamp organized by the Society for children and adolescents with ADHD; it aims to enhance their self-esteem and improve their social skills;

**TRI-MEDIA CAMPAIGNS** — in partnership with media entities, the Society has raised the level of awareness on ADHD through printed articles, and TV and radio plugs/interviews;

**PUBLICATIONS** — these includes newsletters, a magazine, compilations of conference handouts and a Teacher's Manual.

**LIBRARY** — contains the latest books, magazines, handouts, manuals, videos and other publications about AD/HD. It is open to the public.

GOVERNMENT LINKAGES — the Society holds consultations and coordinates with various government agencies like the National Commission on Disability Affairs (NCDA), DSWD and DepEd regularly; it also took part in the finalization of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of the Persons With Disability (PWD) card.

NATIONAL CONFERENCE - held every other year, the Conference brings together foreign and local experts in the fields of medicine and special education who share their knowledge and expertise on timely and relevant issues about ADHD; it is attended by parents, educators, therapists, medical professionals and individuals with ADHD.
