MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

SUBJECT : ATTENDANCE OF GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES IN THE CONFERENCE ON BENEFITS AND WELFARE PROGRAMS

The Philippine Government Employees Association (PGEA) shall host a **Conference on Benefits and Welfare for Government Employees** on August 7, 2000 from 1:00 to 5:00 in the afternoon. The said conference is a continuing activity for government officials and employees who are attending the Symposium on "An Evaluation of the Impact of Privatization of Public Services in the Philippines" in Palawan from 8:00 a.m. to 12 noon which is jointly hosted by the Civil Service Commission and PGEA as provided for in CSC Memorandum Circular No. 10, s. 2000. The primary aim of the Conference is to provide an update on employees' **Benefits Welfare Development Programs** and tackle important issues and concerns of government employees.

These two activities shall be held at Rengel Hotel, Puerto Princesa, Palawan. An educational tour will follow in the morning of August 8. Those interested in the tour should make arrangement with PGEA, the host organization.

In this regard, heads of offices are encouraged to send not more than 3 representatives to these activities on official time subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. For the said Conference on Benefits and Welfare, PGEA shall charge a minimum registration fee of P300.00 per participant.
