SUBJECT : National Crime Prevention Week Celebration (NCPW)

The first week of September of every year has been declared as National Crime prevention Week pursuant to Proclamation No. 461 dated August 31, 1994 which was issued by then Pres. Fidel V. Ramos.

This year's theme "*Kapit Bisig Kabataan Tungo sa Kapayapaan, Now Na !*" focuses on the youth's support for the anti-crime campaign. It aims to establish and/or strengthen the student crime prevention network and multi-sectoral linkages and solicit involvement of national government agencies, the private sector, particularly business groups, interfaith, academe and non-government organizations.

All government agencies are enjoined to actively participate in the celebration, and if possible, conduct simple activities on crime prevention during the flag raising ceremony.
