MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

SUBJECT : PRAISE Winners as Nominees to the Search for Outstanding Government Workers for 2019 and Years Thereafter

The Civil Service Commission, through *CSC Memorandum Circular No. 01 dated February 13, 2019*, announced the start of the 2019 Search for Outstanding Government Workers, enjoining agencies to adopt the revised guidelines on the Search for 2019 and years thereafter and to submit their nominations to the nearest Civil Service Regional or Provincial/Field Office.

Over the years, the CSC has partnered with government agencies in the search for public service exemplars as they can best identify, recognize and reward them through their Program on Rewards and Incentives for Service Excellence (PRAISE) Committees.

To institutionalize and strengthen the involvement of agencies in the conduct of the Search, heads of agencies are encouraged to automatically nominate their PRAISE awardees to the Search. Submission of nominations must not be later than March 31 of each year.
